MEDICATION DROP-OFF NEW GUIDELINES





EMPTY ALL PILLS alable bags

KEEP ALL LIQUIDS, **CREAMS & POWDERS** in original containers



RECYCLE

empty pill bottles & paper boxes

DISCARD

all plastic caps in the garbage



DROP OFF

all bags of pills, liquids, creams and powders at designated locations throughout Outagamie, Winnebago and Calumet Counties

SAFE DRUG DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is Saturday, April 27, BUT here in Winnebago County we have drug drop off locations all year round! Drug drop off sites in Winnebago County are located at the Oshkosh Public Safety Building and the police departments in Neenah, Menasha and Fox Crossing.

However, if it is hard for you to get to a drug drop off location... Call the Housing Authority Nurses Lori and Erin at 920-424-1470 extension 124 and they will arrange to bring them for you!

Whatever you do... DO NOT keep expired or unused medications thinking you can use them later, DO NOT flush unused or expired medications down the toilet or pour into the sink and DO NOT throw any unused or expired medications in the trash.

What Medications are accepted at a drug drop off site?

Bring: Prescription (controlled and non-controlled) and over-the-counter medications, ointments, patches, non -aerosol sprays, inhalers, creams, vials, pet medications, vape pens with the batteries removed. All liquids must be in their original container.

> Do Not Bring: Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, aerosol cans, bio-hazardous materials (anything containing a bodily fluid or blood), mercury thermometers, personal care products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreens, etc...), household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas) or vape pens/e-cigarette devices with a built-in battery that cannot be removed.
